Guidelines for Screening Round to be held on 15th September 2021:

Materials/Apps needed:

- i. Zoom App (for video interface i.e., online-proctoring),
- ii. Classmarker account (for attempting MCQs/screening round) and
- iii. Computer and mobile for camera for proctoring
- iv. Good internet connectivity

Time of Screening test: 3.00 PM to 4.00 PM (1 hour) on 15-09-21

Total marks: 90 (1 mark for correct answer and -0.25 for each incorrect answer)

Mandatory Requirements:

- Android, iOS or Microsoft based Computer/Smartphone with a browser compatibility and built-in rear and front camera.
- Mobile internet or WIFI network with at least 1Mbps upload and download speeds.
- ❖ At least 1.5 GB of Data availability on the network per day.
- Classmarker.com, ZOOM Video Conference apps installed on the Computer/Smart phone to be available during the online proctoring.
- The college team should register in the Classmarker beforehand. The login and password for the exam will be shared at appropriate time through whatsapp group and emails.
- You must keep the Team Name (as provided by organizing team) as name in ZOOM App/Software.
- All the three students participating as a team should sit at one place and the zoom video conference should cover all the 3 students along with the computer screen as much as possible.
- A faculty of the respective institute may be kindly asked for physical invigilation during the examination and the same may be forwarded by mail to the organizing team
- The availability of internet and connectivity is to be managed by the participants and organizers are not responsible for the same.

Checklist to be verified at least one day prior to the Screening test:

- ✓ Do we (Team) have a laptop with front camera or smart phone with front and back cameras?
- ✓ Do we have a smart phone with updated Firefox/safari/chrome browsers?
- ✓ Do we have/upgraded to 1.5 GB data/day plan with at least 1 Mbps upload & download speeds?
- ✓ Did we install the ZOOM Video Conference apps on my mobile/laptop?
- ✓ Did we keep TEAM Name (as provided by the organizing team) as name in ZOOM app/software?
- ✓ Do we have login credentials and am able to login to all the above-mentioned Apps? (login credentials for www.classmarker.com will be provided by the organizing team to all the registered teams by 5.00 PM of 14-09-21 along with the team names)
- ✓ Did we identify an appropriate, well-lit, noise-free place in the house with table and chair for selecting answers comfortably?
- ✓ Have we gone through the video link or weblink for answering questions as sent by the organizing team?

Student should follow the following steps for smooth conduct of Screening test:

- 1) Students must Login to Classmarker.com by 2:40 PM with the credentials (user id, password) sent to them in the given mail id by the organizing team on 14-09-21
- 2) You MUST be seated at least 2 feet away from the camera (laptop or mobile) in such a way that the surroundings are clear and the proctor has a clear view of the entire set-up along with the 3 students and computer screen. Hence there should be another mobile camera to focus computer screen along with the candidates such that the camera can be placed sideways to cover both at a certain height.
- 3) Online Proctor can instruct you to change your seating if things aren't clear/anything objectionable is found.
- 4) Provide access to your microphone (laptop or mobile) and to the front camera (laptop or mobile) by selecting 'Unmute' and 'Show video' in your ZOOM App.
- 5) Proctor will record the session (Permission will be granted by administrator).
- 6) **Timing/No. of Questions/ Syllabus:** The screening test will start at 03.00 PM sharp. There will be total 90 Questions in total (30 from Anatomy, 30 from Physiology, 30 from Biochemistry) covering the entire syllabi of 1st MBBS. Each question will have a single correct answer with 3 distractors. A time period of 40 seconds will be provided for answering each MCQ after which the screen will change accordingly for the next question. One can come back and reattempt/ change the selected option before the final submission within due time. The sequence of questions will be randomly rearranged for each user.
- 7) Marks- Total marks will be 90. (1 mark for correct answer and -0.25 for each incorrect answer). In case of a tie break where the teams have scored equal marks, the team with a smaller number of incorrect responses will be ranked higher.
- 8) The selected 15 teams will be provided with the next round of topics to prepare for Round 1 (semifinal on 24-09-21) and Round 2 (finals to be held on 25-09-21).

- The seminar topics will be provided by 16-09-21 along with the guidelines for preparation of slides and presentation along with the marking scheme on which they will be evaluated.
- The selection of topics (for both the rounds) for each team will be done on a random basis by token system.
- It is to note that all the identities of the presenting team will be masked during the presentation for fairness of evaluation.
- 9) For Round 1- the seminar topics will be integrated ones and 1 presentation/team will be allowed. Whereas in Round 2 each team (6 in number selected in Round 1) will present the designated topics on all the 3 subjects (Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry) such that each member of a team will present one topic.
- 10) The complete details & guidelines for the main event on 24th & 25th will be emailed & uploaded on website along with the results on 16-09-2021

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
