Report on - world conservation day

World conservation day was celebrated on 28.07.2022 on the AIIMS Mangalagiri campus. A host of events and activities were organized by the institute's students, nursing officers, staff, and faculty. The efforts were undertaken under the ages of the social and environment club of the students and the sanitation and hygiene committee under the Kayakalp scheme. The following events were organized.

1. Tree plantation program:
