Sub: Nomination of Faculty Incharge & Constitution of Committees for <u>"Kayakalp Award Scheme for the Tertiary Care Hospitals"</u>.

Background: With a view to maintain the highest level of hygiene and sanitation in the public hospitals through range of instruments including outsourcing and to change the mind-set and perception about public hospitals, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India has evolved a Scheme named "Kayakalp" in the year 2015 for tertiary care hospitals with the following objectives:

- 1. To promote a high degree of cleanliness, hygiene and infection control practices in public Health Care facilities.
- 2. To incentivize and recognize such healthcare facilities that show exemplary performance in adhering to standard protocols of cleanliness and infection control.
- 3. To inculcate a culture of on-going assessment and external review of performance related to hygiene, cleanliness and sanitation in Central Government Hospitals/ Institutions.
- 4. To create and share sustainable practices related to improved cleanliness in Central Government Hospitals/ Institutions linked to positive health outcome.

To incentivize and recognize such public health healthcare facilities (Central Hospitals / Institutions) that show exemplary performance in adhering to standard protocol of cleanliness and infection control, it has been decided to give awards to the Central Government Hospitals / Institutes by identifying the cleanest health care facilities among these Hospitals/ Institutes through an established institutional mechanism viz. internal assessment, peer assessment & external assessment.

The award money for the scheme shall be as follows:

- i) Winner Rs. 2.00 Crore
- ii) Runner- up Rs. 1.00 Crore
- iii) Commendation Rs.50.00 Lakh to any Hospital score scoring more than 80% of Marks on Award criteria and Weightage.
