## Instructions for Reporting for MBBS Admission at AIIMS-Mangalagiri (NEET-UG 2024)

Dear, Student,

On behalf of AIIMS Mangalagiri, I congratulate you and your family on your success.

As per the results of the first round of counseling conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) for NEET-UG 2024 admissions, you have been allotted a seat at AIIMS Mangalagiri. Please carefully review the instructions provided by MCC regarding the reporting and admission process on their official website. According to the MCC schedule, you are required to report to the AIIMS Mangalagiri between 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2024, to 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 to complete the admission process for the first round.

- **List of Documents to be brought on day of reporting**

**A. Exam and Counselling related**

1. Provisional Seat Allotment Letter from MCC
2. NEET/NTA Scorecard
3. NTA Admit card
4. Five Passport size Photographs.
5. Identity Proof (Aadhar Card/ Election Card/Passport or any photo identity proof issued by Government of India.

**B. Eligibility and category related**

1. Certificate of having passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examinations, showing the subject offered by him/her in the Examination
2. Certificate from the Board from which he/she passed the High School/Higher Secondary Examination, showing his/her date of birth.

3. Certificate/Mark sheet from the Board from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examination showing that he/she has secured 60% or more marks (60% in case of UR and OBC, 50% in case of SC/ST, 45% in case of Persons with Benchmark Disability) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

4. Migration Certificate from the University/Board last attended by him/her.

**5. Applicable only to candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe/OBC/EWS/OPH Category**

**a.** SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority. Community should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.

**b.** OBC Certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the central list of OBC. OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy layer. OBC certificate must be in the prescribed format. (The OBC certificates issued from 1st April, 2023 (inclusive) and start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counselling (as per Medical Counselling Committee for MBBS admission) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2024.

**c.** EWS Certificate issued by the competent authority. The EWS certificates issued from 1st April, 2023 (inclusive) and start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counselling (as per Medical Counselling Committee for MBBS admission) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2024.

**d.** Certificate from prescribed authority showing that he/she belongs to Persons with Benchmark Disability Category. Those candidates who join MBBS course at AIIMS, Mangalagiri his/her original certificates will be retained and the same will not be returned to the candidate before completion of the course.
